In order to be certified under the U.S.-EU & Swiss Safe Harbor Framework, PharmaVigilant had to comply with the seven Safe Harbor Principles: Notice, Choice, Onward Transfer, Access, Security, Data Integrity and Enforcement. These Principles enable U.S. companies to more efficiently serve the needs of their clients and minimize delays in the transfer of data.
